# FIREFIGHTERS WEWORIAL PLAZA

A memorial that honors past, present and future firefighters



The Firefighters Memorial Plaza will annually memorialize all line of duty firefighter fatalities in Illinois.

All Illinois line of duty deaths since 1857 will be engraved on bronze plaques on the base of the statue. As of 2020, this consisted of over 900 names. New line of duty deaths will be added yearly...the only memorial of its kind.

**HOW IT STARTED:** In 1994, ten local fire departments participated in the first "Elgin Area Firefighter Memorial Service". This annual service has been conducted every year since at the Elgin Fire Museum (old Fire Station 5) at 533 St. Charles St., in the heart of the southeast side of Elgin.

As the memorial service has grown over the years, its purpose has reached deep into many communities and their local fire departments. During this time, an unexpected benefit from the memorial service arose. Each year, grieving families share their loss and love with the larger fire service community. In turn, this support has encouraged many families to return year after year to comfort other families who are experiencing the same loss. That is the spirit and soul of this memorial plaza. It will be a site worthy of the annual firefighter memorial service; a place to recognize public servants and the selfless dedication they provided to their communities.

**HOW IT'S GOING:** Groundbreaking took place on June 26, 2021. Estimated costs of the memorial plaza are projected to be \$250,000. To date, \$207,000 has been raised since May 2019. Design of the plaza is 99% complete and fundraising continues to support the final design. With material costs rising, the fundraising goal is within site. Please help to make this 30 year idea a reality!

The fundraising has been provided by individuals, private sources and businesses. The donation amounts have ranged from \$25 to \$20,000. We have worked very hard to secure in-kind donations. To date, architectural, excavation and electrical services have been donated as well as many other contractors' services.
